- A solar eclipse happens when the Moon positions between the Earth and the Sun.
- The dark side of the Moon's shadow will blanket the Earth.
- The shadow, the umbra, a type of cone with no direct sunlight, and the penumbra, light received from some of the Sun sometimes result in a less than total solar eclipse, or partial solar eclipse.
- A total solar eclipse happens when the Sun is totally blocked by the moon!
- Solar eclipses always take place with a new moon. Lunar eclipses always take place with a full moon.
- There are 2 eclipse "seasons" every year. They normally occur every year around late winter or early/mid Spring. The 2nd round occurs usually later in the year around Autumn early winter.
- Total eclipses are rare historically and statistically speaking.
- Animals are affected by eclipses, lunar and solar! They always remain in tune with nature.
- A total solar eclipse can last approximately 7 ½ minutes. A lunar eclipse can last 2 hours or longer.

- Solar eclipses repeat particular cycles every few hundred years. Phenomenally, we may at times experience an exact eclipse that people in a different culture hundreds of years ago experienced the same.
- According to criminal reports, it's an unavoidable fact that many strange happenings, including crimes, happen during an eclipse, especially a lunar eclipse.
- Nature also responds differently to eclipses. Weather, animals, insects, plants, gardens, crops, often reveal dramatic change during eclipses.
- Domestic pets are affected by eclipses!
- The oldest known recorded solar eclipse took place in 1226 BCE, recorded primitively.
- Albert Einstein's theory of relativity was prompted by scientific evidence by the solar eclipse of 1919.
- Many dramatic changes in History are thought to have been precipitated by eclipses.
- The solar eclipse of April 8, 2024 is considered to be one of the rare eclipses that will go down in History!
